




## Engage Your Kids at the National Medal of Honor Heritage Center!

<p><b>Before Your Visit</b></p> <p><i>Prepare</i></p>	<p>Plan to spend about an hour and a half touring the National Medal of Honor Heritage Center. Here are a few tips to help you prepare for your visit.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ Download the free app using the QR Code in the lobby and bring headphones for additional information as you explore the gallery. <p><b>During Your Visit</b></p> <p><i>Think &amp; Learn</i></p>	<p>The Medal of Honor is the nation’s highest military award for acts of valor. There are six character values embodied by the Medal of Honor and its recipients: patriotism, citizenship, courage, integrity, sacrifice and commitment.
